



Facilities

St Laurence's College offers outstanding facilities across three purpose-built and thoughtfully designed campus', harnessing the perfect blend of original buildings and modern, student-centred learning spaces.

St Laurence's College has exceptional buildings, grounds and facilities which are conducive to promoting an effective learning environment.

Special features include air-conditioned, well-equipped classrooms, science and computer laboratories, library plus specialist rooms for music, television, graphics, design and technology. 
