
KNOX SPORTS AND AQUATIC ACADEMY

KNOX PERFORMING ARTS CENTRE

This facility includes:

- A 700 seat multipurpose auditorium (the Wenkart Theatre), for music and theatrical performances, with a large stage, an adjustable orchestra pit, cutting-edge lighting and sound equipment, as well as tiered seating
- Drama theatre with 165 seats for intimate drama performances and recitals
- Purpose-built dance studio for traditional and contemporary dance
- Two dedicated large music rehearsal rooms
